Pre-school Ready to Harvest Rainwater

When the winter rains begin to fall in Yulansoni (hopefully this month), our pre-school will be equipped to harvest water. This is exciting news for water-starved Yulansoni.

The primary purpose of this project is to provide water at the pre-school for lunchtime, cooking, drinking, and hand washing. Future plans may call for an additional collection tank to use for garden irrigation.

Much of the credit for this project goes to our Fall 2008 mission team, who purchased and began installing the guttering.



FDM USA RECEIVES MICROFINANCE GRANT

Grant funding for a sustainable economic improvement program (micro-finance) in the village of Yulansoni will soon be available. On October 6 FDM received notice of approval of a grant through the Journey Foundation in the amount of \$6,300 to be used in 2009 for the purpose of small business loans.

Located in the Singida region of Tanzania, Yulansoni village has a population of about 2,000 inhabitants, with another 3,000 living in surrounding areas. This micro-finance grant will be a wonderful opportunity for those with an entrepreneurial spirit to break the chains of poverty. The grant will provide loans to start up much-needed small, value-added businesses which will earn revenue and provide training.

Pastor William Makali, President of Full Dimensions Ministry of Christ-Tanzania (FDMC), will oversee the program. The grant money, when received by FDM-USA, will be wire-transferred to the FDMC account at Barclays Bank Tanzania. FDMC will then transfer all funds to the National Microfinance Bank in Kiombi to be deposited in the account of the Yulansoni Rural Microfinance Credit Facility.

What's Happening in Tanzania? FDM's Operations Plan

During a November 2007 mission trip to the Yulansoni village, several FDM Board members worked with Pastor William and village leaders to develop an operations plan for FDM. The group came up with immediate short-term priorities and longer-term items which need to be evaluated as time goes on.

<u>Priority Items</u>	<u>Status</u>
New Pre-school Roof	Completed 1st Quarter 08
New Ward Building	Nearing completion at end of 2008, despite loss of one Month due to a delivery truck accident.
Additional Water Harvesting	New system now in place on pre-school roof. Plans to build more.
Small, on-demand generator	Scheduled to begin 1st Quarter 09 . We are trying to combine with solar energy.

<u>Longer-term Items</u>	<u>Status</u>
Deep well drilling	This item has become an active project. FDM is partnering with Living Waters International (LWI) on this project. FDM has raised its share of the total cost (1/2 of the estimated total cost of \$17,000). A water survey was completed and paid for in November 08. FDM is awaiting action by LWI.
Agricultural Initiatives (crop selection, irrigation, etc.)	Soil samples have been taken and analyzed. Future course of action to be set during an April 09 mission trip.
Solar Oven, Solar Water Pasteurization	No action to date.
Partner with Heifer International	Discussions to take place n April 09.
Oil Seed Press	No action to date.

What's Happening in Tanzania? 2008 in Review

In addition to the achievements on the “priority items” listed at left, FDM celebrates the following accomplishments in 2008:

- Pastor William and his assistants have shared the Christian gospel with approximately 1,600 people in 2008.
- By the end of 2008, the doctor at the Yulansoni clinic will have seen more than 2,500 patients.
- Received approval for a grant from the Journey Foundation for developing a microfinance economic program in Yulansoni.
- Funded surgery to correct a village child's spina bi-fida.
- Built school desks for the pre-school
- Continued to develop, define, and implement the Strategic Operating Plan for FDM USA.
- FDM's Yulansoni clinic has been granted registration and certification at the Tanzanian national level.
- Met commitment of quarterly financial support for operation of the Yulansoni medical clinic and pre-school.
